

Psychics

Animal Communicator – Speaks to your pet’s Higher Self or soul to relay messages usually about food and care – things that are important to the pet that the owner doesn’t know.

Astrologers – calculates birth data to predict future events and best courses of action.

Clairience/Claïroolfaction/Claïrgustance – ability to smell a spirit – perfume or tobacco of the deceased, or the psychic receives taste impressions from a spirit such as a favorite food.

Clairaudient – psychic who hears voices and relays messages based on what they hear.

Claircognizance – clear knowing without receiving information from normal sources.

Clairsentient aka EMPATH – receives intuitive information from feelings. This could be a gut feeling or inner knowing and relays messages accordingly. May also feel what others feel.

Clairvoyant – Since most people in society are visual, this is the most common kind of psychic who sees visions and gives advice and direction to clients.

Currandero(a) – folk doctor/ medicine (wo)man. Prescribes herbs. Common in Mexico.

Medical Intuitive – uses spiritual gifts to gaze into the body and relay information about previously unknown or undiagnosed medical conditions. Not necessarily a healer, but helps to bring the conditions to light so medical treatment can be sought.

Medium – Person who acts as a mediator between the living and the dead.

- 1) **Mental Mediumship** – hears messages via clairaudience and relays them.
- 2) **Trance Mediumship** – practitioner goes into an altered state to give messages.
- 3) **Physical Mediumship** – Spirit uses the psychic’s energy to create physical manifestations documented in spirit photography.
- 4) **Direct Voice** – sounds independent of the medium such as trumpets – uncommon.
- 5) **Channeling** – medium allows spirit to take over their body and speak through them. They bring information through from unseen sources that they sometimes share with the public, while at other times, they illusively keep their sources to themselves. Some are ungrounded and flaky, speaking in non-stop run on sentences, while others reveal hidden truth within stunningly beautiful prose. What or who are they channeling?
 - 1) Angels
 - 2) Spirit Guides
 - 3) Dead People

Numerologist – calculates the numbers of your birth and current year to make predictions.

Palmistry – art of predicting the future by studying the lines on the hands.

Runes – psychic casts the runes in various spreads to answer questions and make predictions.

Tarot – highly symbolic card images help the psychic create client predictions. Many different kinds of decks these days. Most famous is the **Rider Waite Tarot** – my favorite!

Healers

Healers assist people energetically, helping clients straighten out the unwanted influences stuck in the energy fields within and around the body. Healers can be hyper sensitive and are often vegetarian, vegan and demand hypo-allergenic everything. They dislike perfumes and chemicals but are often dowsed in essential oils. Some practice laying on of hands with clients or place their palms over the energy fields surrounding the body in order to shift energy and help clients create balance in main areas of life – love, health or money/financial. Common healers include:

Chiropractors – manipulate the spine to create healing.

Dowsers – use pendulums (rock on a rope) to detect blocks in the field.

Hypnotherapist/Regressionist – uses guided imagery and visualization to help clients go into past lives or to visualize people who wronged them so they can forgive, or have visionary encounters with deceased loved ones to heal grief.

Reflexologists – press pressure points in the soles of the feet and palms to create healing.

Reiki Healer – practices the method developed by Mikao Usui in Japan. The most common and popular healing method on the planet. Reiki healers run energy through their hands into the bodies of their clients in order to bring balance.

Common Tools Used by Psychics

Crystals & Gemstones – used by laying on the body or holding during psychic readings.

Essential Oils – lavender is most common and helps clients relax.

Flower Essences – homeopathy created using energetic aspects of flowers and trees.

Pendulum – rock on a rope can be used to detect blocks in energy.

Sage Wand –practitioner burns a bundle of sage and uses the smoke to remove bad vibes.

Jargon

Aura – colored light that surrounds the body. Can be interpreted by a photographer.

Chakras – colored lights within the physical body undetectable to the naked eye. Healers remove blocks from chakras which are red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet & white.

Psychic Vampire – no relation to Bram Stoker! ☺ These people knowingly or unknowingly suck the life out of others. Healers help clients shield themselves from them.

Vortex – a special place on the planet that New Agers believe will open them up to receive blessings or psychic powers due to special energy in the electromagnetic fields in that particular area. Sedona, Arizona, is a great example.
